

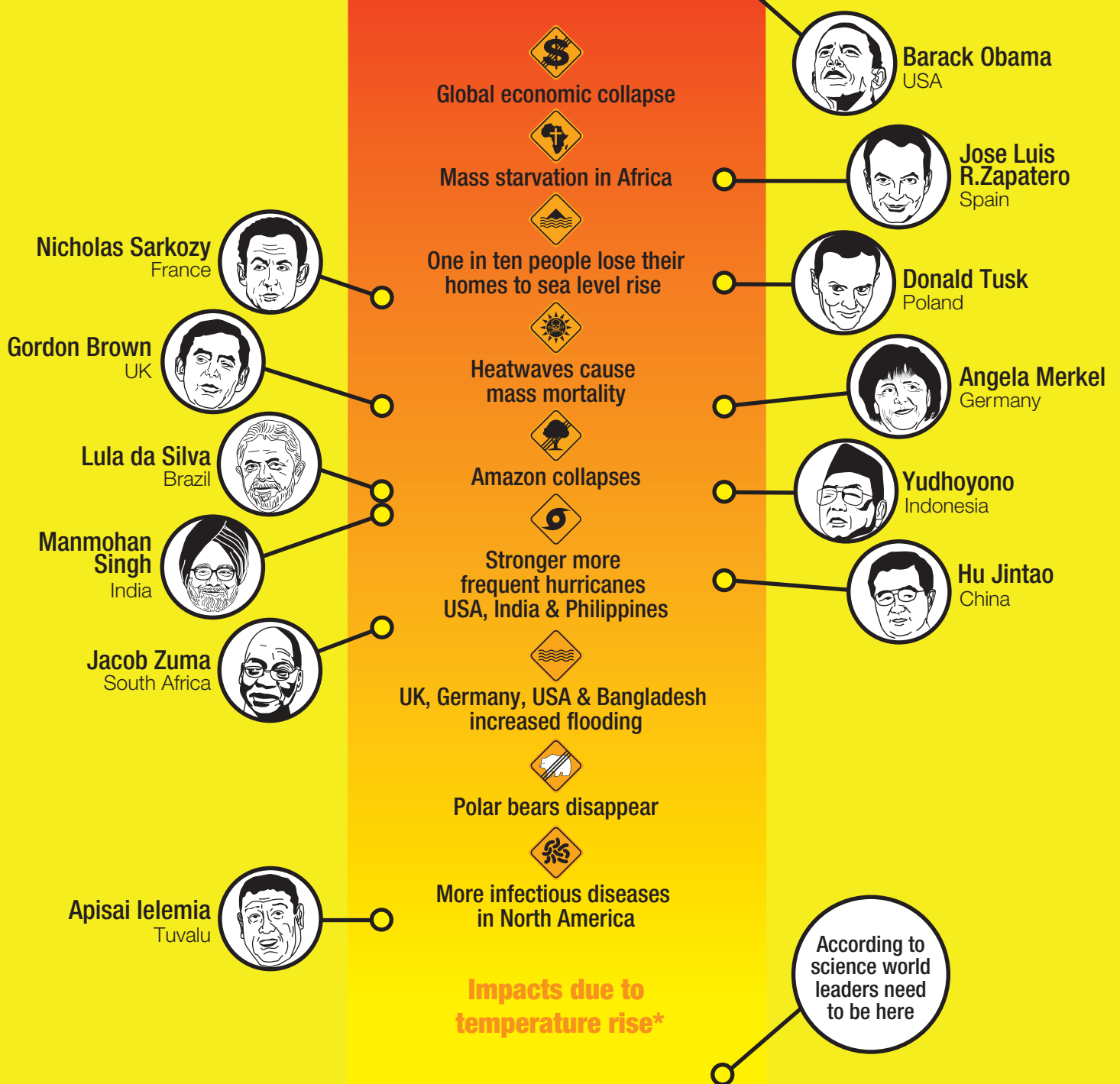
Climate Science vs. Climate Politics
